Miami, Florida

Jump-start your morning in true Miami style with a Cuban cafecito from a ventanita (a streetside shop window). Then climb the historic lighthouse at Bill Baggs Cape Florida State Park on quiet Key Biscayne before lounging on its secluded sands below. Explore Wynwood's vibrant art scene. Cruise from Miami to step inside the Renaissance-style Vizcaya estate for a look into Miami's dazzling past.

Havana, Cuba

Step into a time warp where classic cars, stately squares, and crumbling estates hint at a history begging to be discovered. Havana may be a look into the past, but its iconic music, distinctive culture, and nostalgic allure never get old.

Cienfuegos, Cuba

This Cuban gem is nicknamed the "Pearl of the South" for its picturesque bay – but the real sparkle of Cienfuegos is the assortment of adventures. Go Kayaking or snorkeling around coral reefs. Explore the UNESCO-listed historic center by vintage tank. Take a ferry to 18th-century Castillo de Jagua. Meet pink flamingos in Guanaroca Lagoon. Or see the world's tallest stalagmite in Martin Infierno Cave.

Santiago De Cuba, Cuba

Discover the passionate essence of Santiago de Cuba first-hand as you walk the 100-year-old Padre Pico Steps to the old French quarter of Tivoli.
