Board our motorcoach this morning and travel through several states to your overnight stop where lodging has been arranged for your group. *Please pack an overnight bag.*

Mon., Oct. 1

After breakfast, check out and travel into Florida. Upon arrival in Jacksonville, you will check into Windham Garden Hotel and have time to freshen up before enjoying dinner and a leisurely evening.

Tues., Oct. 2

After breakfast, board your motorcoach and meet your guide for a **tour of Jacksonville**. Originally one of the oldest cities in the new world, Jacksonville is one of the largest and most modern to be found anywhere. There will be time for lunch on your own, then continue to the **Anheuser-Busch Brewery for a self-guided visit** of the brewing process and sampling their most famous beer. Afterwards, visit **Jacksonville Landing** where you can enjoy dinner on your own, followed by a live theatrical production at **Limelight Theatre**.

Wed., Oct. 3

Once again, enjoy breakfast at your hotel, then it's off for a **guided tour of Amelia Island**. As you travel north through Fort George Island, a stop will be made at **Kingsley Plantation**. The plantation house is the oldest still standing in the state, and the remains of the slave quarters are a rare remnant from Antebellum American life. You've traveled from the present to colonial, now step into the Victorian Era with a **tour of Amelia Island** and the former seaport village of Fernandina Beach. There will be time to enjoy lunch on your own here, then stop at **American Beach** at the southern end the island. In 1935, the Afro-American Life Insurance Company purchased 200 acres, which was eventually transformed into a glorious oceanfront haven for African Americans during the Jim Crow-era of segregation. Dinner will once again be arranged this evening at a local restaurant.

Thurs., Oct. 4

After a delicious breakfast at your hotel, depart for historic **St. Augustine**, one of the oldest continually occupied European settlements in the United States. Meet your guide for a **tour of the city** to include a perimeter tour of **Castillo De San Marcos**. There will be some free time on St. George's Street and in the **Spanish Quarter** for lunch and shopping. No visit to this area would be complete without a visit to the famous **Ponce de Leon's "Fountain of Youth"** where you can even drink from the original well thought to bring immortality. Dinner has been arranged for the group in the area, then return to your hotel

Fri., Oct. 5

Enjoy breakfast, then check out and travel to your overnight stop where you will check into your hotel (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.

Sat., Oct. 6

Following breakfast, check out and depart for home with fond memories of your **St. Augustine**, **Amelia Island & Jacksonville**.
