Tentative Itinerary – pick ups or times may change



MONDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2019:

5:00 am Indiana (Wal-Mart, near former Rita's)
5:30 am Clymer (Tate's)
6:00 am Northern Cambria (Bi-Lo)
6:30 am Ebensburg (Community College / Big Lots parking lot, upper end away from store)

Travel to Killington / Rutland area of Vermont (approx. 485 miles)
Rest and meal stops en route

5:00 pm Approximate arrival at in the KILLINGTON, VERMONT area for a one night stay.

DINNER is included this evening.

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 15, 2019:

BREAKFAST is included this morning at your hotel.

A VERMONT LOCAL GUIDE will meet you for local touring. Start your day with a breath of the Vermont crisp air and a view of these beautiful surroundings. During your tour of central Vermont, you'll visit the VERMONT MARBLE MUSEUM/EXHIBIT. The exhibit focuses on the company's history, the geology of marble, its' uses in art, architecture, and industry. Busts of nearly all the Presidents, The Last Supper, and other works can be viewed throughout the museum. Watch carving demonstrations and ask questions of local sculptors. Visit the extensive gift shop for marble goods.

This afternoon, you will visit PLYMOUTH NOTCH, the birthplace and boyhood home of PRESIDENT CALVIN COOLIDGE. You will visit the historical museum, community church, cheese factory, schoolhouse, general store and cemetery where the President is buried. Enjoy some time for lunch on own in WOODSTOCK, a quaint village that even has a COVERED BRIDGE!

Bid farewell to your local guide and travel to NEW HAMPSHIRE, "the Granite State".

Arrive in the WATERVILLE VALLEY area and check into your lodging for a TWO NIGHT STAY. You'll have time to browse the shops in Town Square and enjoy the breathtaking views of the White Mountains or relax by the fire!

Depart for dinner.

DINNER is included this evening.

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2019:

HEARTY CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST is included this morning at your lodge.

Meet your LOCAL GUIDE at your lodge for a day of touring New Hampshire!

Arrive at the Flume Gorge and FRANCONIA NOTCH VISITOR'S CENTER. There are historical displays, a wonderful 20 minute interpretive DVD, a coffee shop, gift shop and rest rooms! Some folks may want to take a partial tour of the Gorge.

Travel through Franconia Notch State Park. Stop to view the Old Man of the Mountain Historic Site.

Tour through Crawford Notch with photo stops of the Omni Mount Washington Hotel, the Elephant Head rock formation and Silver Cascade, and then NORTH CONWAY for lunch on own.

Lunch on own and shopping time in the village of North Conway.

Tour the KANCAMAGUS National Scenic Byway with stops at the Albany Covered Bridge, Rocky Gorge, Sugar Hill overlook as time and weather allow. Travel through the former logging town of Lincoln. *LOON GONDOLA located in the heart of the White Mountain National Forest. Soar to the 2,750 foot summit on New Hampshire's longest, scenic Gondola Skyride and enjoy spectacular views. At the top watch local artisans produce unique crafts, climb the observation tower or visit the Summit Café for a snack.*

Approximate return to the lodge, with your local guide.

Depart for dinner.

DINNER is included this evening.

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 17, 2019:

HEARTY CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST is included this morning at the lodge.

Depart and travel south through the beautiful lakes region of New Hampshire to the southern MAINE SEACOAST.

A rest stop will be made enroute.

Welcome to MAINE, "the Pine State". Enjoy free time for lunch on your own in Dock Square, KENNEBUNKPORT. There are many quaint shops and eateries along the waterfront. (motor coach parking is included)

Depart Kennebunkport and drive past the Bush compound at Walkers Point on your way to Portland.

Arrive in Portland and meet your LOCAL GUIDE for a tour of PORTLAND - Maine's largest city-by-the-sea. You will view Longfellow's boyhood home, sea captain houses and the elegant Victoria Mansion as you drive through historic neighborhoods overlooking the islands of Casco Bay in Portland Harbor.

Your tour includes a stop at Portland Head Light. This historic landmark is the most photographed lighthouse in America, set in Fort Williams Park with crashing surf, a beach, and an old fort

Check in for a two night stay at the in the SOUTH PORTLAND, MAINE.

Depart for dinner. DINNER is included this evening.

FRIDAY, OCTOBER 18, 2019:

BREAKFAST at the hotel.

Your LOCAL GUIDE will meet you at your hotel for a FULL DAY of touring. Get acquainted with highlights of the midcoast region as you travel to Boothbay Harbor, the boating capitol of Maine.

Enjoy a scenic, narrated BOOTHBAY HARBOR CRUISE aboard Cap'n Fish's boat. You'll pass by beautiful vacation homes, lighthouses, small islands as well as a visit with the seals on the ledges.

Enjoy some free time to explore Boothbay Harbor's picturesque waterfront. This resort town has retained the atmosphere of an old New England village. Fishing craft lie alongside wharves that follow the quaint, winding village streets lined with shops and art galleries.

Don your SOUVENIR LOBSTER HAT for a TRADITIONAL MAINE LOBSTER LUNCHEON today. (alternate selection is available).

Depart and travel to Bath.

Tour the MAINE MARITIME MUSEUM. Located on the banks of the Kennebec River, the museum depicts Maine's shipbuilding industry from the 1600's to the present. Numerous hands on exhibits, boat building demonstrations, and a lobstering exhibit are here for you to see on the grounds of an historic shipyard. (Depart at 4:30 PM for Freeport)

Free time in Freeport for dinner on own. There are many restaurants available within walking distance of the famed LL BEAN FLAGSHIP STORE! Your local guide will acquaint you with the dining options.

Depart Freeport and return to the hotel.

Arrive back at the hotel. For those who wish to eat later, there is a restaurant and lounge attached to the hotel.

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2019:

BREAKFAST is included this morning at your hotel.

Depart hotel and travel to MASSACHUSETTS, "the Bay State".

Arrive in STURBRIDGE and step back in time at OLD STURBRIDGE VILLAGE, a re-creation of a rural New England town. You'll have the afternoon to enjoy lunch on your own and strolling through this community of the 1830's.

Depart Old Sturbridge Village.

Enroute to your lodging, stop for an included DINNER in the heart of Palmer, The Steaming Tender Restaurant. Set on the grounds of historic Frederick Law Olmsted Park, constructed by the landscaper in the mid 19th century, Steaming Tender Restaurant is situated inside of a 19th century Romanesque style train station. During its time, The Palmer Railroad Station was the 3rd largest station in Massachusetts, and helped give Palmer the nickname "The Town of Seven Railroads" that still persists today.

Check into your lodging in CHICOPEE, MASSACHUSETTS area lodging for a one night stay.

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 20, 2019:

BREAKFAST is included this morning at the hotel.

8:30 am Approximate departure

Rest and meal stops en route

9:00 pm Approximate return time to Ebensburg, followed by other stops.
